KSF CONTINGENT SUCCESSFULLY CONDUCTED SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATION IN TÜRKIYE



KSF contingent has successfully completed a noble mission in saving lives from the tragedy in Türkiye, during the search and rescue operation in the areas affected by the earthquake.

The KSF Search and Rescue teams, during the search and rescue operation, showed professionalism, dedication and high performance that resulted in the saving of four lives of citizens of the Republic of Türkiye.

To congratulate them for the contribution, commitment and success shown during this two-week operation, at the International Airport of Pristina they were solemnly hosted by the Prime Minister of the Republic of Kosovo, Albin Kurti, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj together

with the Commander of the Kosovo Security Force, Lieutenant General



Bashkim Jashari, Commander of the National Guard, Brigadier General Naim Haziri, Ambassador of Türkiye in Kosovo, officers of the KSF and the contingent from Türkiye serving in Kosovo as well as family members.



On this occasion, the Commander of the Kosovo Security Force rewarded the members who returned from Türkiye with the “Save Lives” motivation. After the decision taken by the state institutions of the Republic of Kosovo and in coordination with the authorities of the Republic of Türkiye, the KSF contingent was deployed on the same day in the areas affected by the earthquake, offering the professional capacities of the Kosovo Security Force units (Urban Search & Rescue, K9, Emergency Medicine) to assist the Republic of Türkiye cope with easier this tragedy.

Bashkim Jashari, Ambassador of Türkiye in Kosovo, Tunç Angili, generals and senhioprn officers of the KSF as well as family members of that KSF Contingent that were part of mission in Türkiye.



On this occasion, President Osmani stated that the KSF Contingent was honored for bravery, courage and unparalleled sacrifice for saving the lives of people affected by the terrible tragedy of the earthquakes in Türkiye, stressing that: “Our Security Force remains synonymous with peace and security in the country and in the world”.



MINISTER MEHAJ CONGRATULATED THE ASSOCIATION FOR SEARCH AND RESCUE FOR THE ASSISTANCE GIVEN IN THE CASE AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE IN TÜRKIYE

After the successful completion of the humanitarian search and rescue mission in Türkiye, where Minister Mehaj hosted the members of the Kosovo Association for Search and Rescue, headed by Milaim Kelmendi. On this occasion, Minister Mehaj heartily congratulated them for their voluntary contribution and the professionalism shown in the search and rescue operation, in the areas affected by the earthquake in Türkiye, where they succeeded in extracting two people alive from the ruins, among of them a child, as well as the removal of dozens of corpses from the ruined buildings.



MINISTER MEHAJ HELD VERY USEFUL MEETINGS AT NATO HEADQUARTERS IN BRUSSELS

Many important topics related to security, challenges, achievements and opportunities of Kosovo's cooperation with NATO were discussed between Minister Mehaj and Deputy Assistant Secretary General for NATO Operations, Burcu San, during his official visit at the NATO headquarters in Brussels.

During this visit, Minister Mehaj was accompanied by the Ambassador of the Republic of Kosovo to NATO, Astrit Zemaj, Acting Chief of Staff of the General Staff of



the KSF, Colonel Ejup Maqedonci and the Chief of the Cabinet of the Minister of Defense, Hasan Hoxha.

The second meeting was held with the Ambassadors of the Quint countries in NATO, while the central meeting was held in the NATO conference hall, where initially, Minister Mehaj presented and informed the ambassadors of the NATO countries about the security situation in the world and the impact in the Western Balkans, then for its objectives for the development of the Force, bilateral and multilateral international cooperation, cooperation with NALT and KFOR, as well as the way forward in terms of cooperation with NATO.



Afterwards, ambassadors from different countries in their addresses highly appreciated the development process of the KSF, its engagement in international operations, the commitment of the Ministry of Defense for cooperation in the management of the situation with Afghan refugees, as well as the dedication of Kosovo for the joint effort of allies and partners after the Russian aggression in Ukraine.

In the end, Minister Mehaj and the delegation from Kosovo held a fruitful meeting with the Dep/Head of the NATO Military Committee, Lieutenant General Lance Landrum, with whom they shared the vision for the development of the KSF in accordance with NATO standards, the joint commitment to maintaining peace and stability as well as increasing cooperation with NALT and KFOR. Among other things, General Landrum discussed the importance of the KSF's participation in the exercise "Defender Europe '23" as well as the status of the Republic of Kosovo, among the host countries of this exercise.

The host of the Kosovo delegation at the NATO headquarters was the ambassador of the United Kingdom to NATO,



David Quarrey, who highly praised the progress of the KSF in all areas. Ambassador Quarrey and his staff accompanied and supported the Kosovo delegation in all the activities developed at the NATO headquarters.

In all the meetings, all the participants emphasized the need to increase the frequency of such meetings in order to support Kosovo on the path of integration into the Euro-Atlantic structures.



THE ACTING MINISTER OF DEFENSE OF FINLAND, MIKKO SAVOLA, AND THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE OF MONTENEGRO, FILIP ADZIC VISITED THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE



In the month of February, Ministry of Defense was visited by Acting Minister of Finland, Mikko Savola as well as acting Minister of Defense of Montenegro, Filip Adzic, who were hosted by Minister Mehaj.

In this meeting between Minister Mehaj with Acting Minister of Defense of Finland was discussed about current geopolitical situation, impact of the Russian aggression in Ukraine, as well as security situation in Kosovo, cooperation with KFOR as well as joint objectives for membership in NATO.

The topic of discussion was also cooperation in the field of security, joint winter training between the two forces and the exchange of experience of the Finnish Army, regarding the concept of the voluntary reserve, which

will soon be a form of service in our army as well.

On this occasion, the Minister in charge, Savola, highly appreciated the cooperation of the KSF with KFOR and expressed his readiness for cooperation in a situation where the goal of membership in NATO and the preservation of stability and peace remain the main efforts of daily engagement.

While in the meeting between Minister Mehaj and the Minister of Internal Affairs and at the same time the Minister of Defense of Montenegro, Filip Adzic, it was discussed about the neighboring cooperation, the development of professional military capacities through the realization of joint exercises and trainings between the two armies, and also about the “Defender Europe ‘23” field exercise. Also, Minister Mehaj informed his Montenegrin counterpart about the developments of the KSF, the implementation phase of the Transition Plan, legal changes, about the latest recruitments, and also about the clear intentions for membership in regional initiatives, in A5, RACVIAC and Partnership for Peace Program.

For his part, Minister Adzic expressed the commitment that the Republic of Kosovo will have the support of Montenegro for membership in the Partnership for Peace Program, as a path to membership in NATO.



Also, also the Minister of Defense of Montenegro, Mr. Filip Adzic was hosted by the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, who informed Minister Adzic, with the achievements, developments, plans of the KSF and the final preparations for the international exercise “Defender Europe 2023”.

The topic of the meeting was the current situation in Ukraine and its impact on our region.

General Jashari and Minister Azdric agreed to continue cooperation in areas of common interest as two partner states.





MINISTER MEHAJ AND GENERAL JASHARI ATTENDED THE MEETING OF THE UKRAINE DEFENSE CONTACT GROUP

In the ninth meeting of the Contact Group for the Defense of Ukraine, held in Brussels during the month of February, among the ministers and chiefs of defense of 54 countries, the Minister of Defense Armend Mehaj and the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, also participated, accompanied by their cabinet chiefs, Hasan Hoxha and Brigadier General Ilir Qeriqi. The meeting was chaired by NATO's General Secretary, Jens Stoltenberg, The Secretary of Defense of the United States, Lloyd Austin and the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, General Mark Milley, who once again emphasized the importance of each of the countries

providing all the necessary assistance to Ukraine and the Ukrainian people who are facing with Russian aggression, an unfair war that must be ended.

THE FIRST KSF CONTINGENT RETURNED FROM A MISSION TO THE FALKLAND'S ISLANDS



The first contingent with KSF troops, which was attached to the British Army, after the successful completion of the mission in the Falkland Islands, "Atlantic", returned to Kosovo at the beginning of February.

To congratulate them for their return home and success in the mission, at the International Airport of Pristina, the members were welcomed by their families, Minister Mehaj, the Commander of the KSF, General Jashari and senior officers and non-commissioned officers of the KSF. The KSF Commander Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, based on evaluations and discussions with British partners, has highly appreciated the performance and professionalism shown. Furthermore, COMKSF emphasized that this

mission is a continuous testimony to the establishment and development of the KSF and the journey towards membership in NATO and other security organizations. This is the second mission abroad of the Kosovo Security Force after the one in Kuwait alongside the American army. Currently, the KSF continues its mission in the Falkland Islands, with the second contingent having deployed this month.



15 YEARS AS A STATE



On the occasion of the 15th anniversary of the country's Independence, the ceremony began with the raising of the flag in the courtyard of the Government of Kosovo and tributes at the "Adem Jashari" memorial complex in Prekaz. In honor of this holiday, the Kosovo Security Force and the Kosovo Police paraded in Pristina, which were applauded by many citizens who came out to celebrate together.



Minister Mehaj on this occasion pointed out that:

"February 17th marks our entire centuries-old past, thousands of years of prisons and battles, civilians killed, men and women raped, and martyrs fallen on the altar of freedom, which like the roots of a trunk keep us bound and steadfast in the Illyrian land. On February 17, 2008, a state that carries democratic values was added to Europe, while the right denied for centuries was established for the people of Kosovo. Nothing would have been possible without the struggle of the Kosovo Liberation Army, the iron will of the activists of the national cause and the help of our international partners, so we are always grateful to them forever".



BERETS CEREMONY FOR KSF UNITS

After the decree of the berets by the President of the Republic of Kosovo, in the “Adem Jashari” Barracks in Pristina, in the presence of the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant



General Bashkim Jashari, as well as senior officers of the Kosovo Security Force, they were distributed in a solemn ceremony. The Minister of Defense and the Commander of the KSF congratulated the members of the Kosovo Security Force on the new berets that will have different colors symbolizing the units of the KSF. The placement of the berets of the KSF units comes alongside professional advancement and the



increase of operational capacities.

COORDINATION MEETING AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR IS HELD BETWEEN MoD, KSF, NALT AND ISG



The Ministry of Defense and the General Staff of the KSF held the coordination meeting between the NATO Liaison Office (NALT) and the American Institute for Security Governance (ISG). During his speech, Minister Mehaj enumerated the achievements for 2022, where, among others, was the addition-amendment of the three basic laws of the MoD and the KSF, the Law on Military Police and the increase in the number of

recruitments.

The focus for 2023 is the drafting and approval of the Defense Strategy, the Draft Law for the Intelligence and Security Agency, the Concept-document for the reserve component, etc. Further in his speech, Minister Mehaj emphasized that the integration of the Republic of Kosovo into NATO should be done as soon as possible and for this he asked for the help and support of international partners.



For his part, the Director of NALT, Brigadier General Joachim Hoppe, congratulated the MoD and the KSF for the organization, stressing that the good cooperation will continue in the future.

COMKSF LIEUTENANT GENERAL BASHKIM JASHARI REPORTED BEFORE THE PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE ON SECURITY AND DEFENSE OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOSOVO
