The meeting was led by the US Secretary of



Defense, Mr. Lloyd Austin, and focused on the continuation of concrete military assistance to Ukraine from the countries of this coalition. In the context of this event, Minister Maqedonci and Lieutenant General Jashari had the opportunity to hold a special meeting with the NATO Assistant Secretary General for Operations, Tom Goffus, with whom they discussed the developments in the Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force of, as well as the general security situation in the country.

At the invitation of his counterpart from North Macedonia, Lieutenant General Vasko Gjurchinovski and co-organized by the US Forces Europe Command (EUCOM), headed by General Christopher Cavoli, the KSF Commander participated in the Conference of Chiefs of Defense of the Adriatic Charter - USA in Skopje, North Macedonia. Major General Stephen Osborn, Commander of the National Guard of Iowa, Kosovo's partner state, also participated in the conference. During the conference, General Jashari addressed the audience in a speech where he presented the achievements of the KSF. Also,



he spoke about the attacks that took place in the north of Kosovo and the fact that they are a threat to the stability of Kosovo and the region. The general reiterated that such things cannot be repeated and the countries that support them should receive the deserved punishment. In the end, General Jashari officially declared to the participants that the time has come for Kosovo to become a full member of the Adriatic Charter. The conference continued its work, where in its context, the Commander of the KSF with his delegation held bilateral meetings with the American delegation headed by General Christopher Cavoli, Commander of the American Forces for Europe (EUCOM). During the meeting, General Jashari presented the achievements of the KSF and thanked General Cavoli for the support and partnership in the military field between the two countries. Also, the security situation in our country and the challenges surrounding it were discussed. General Cavoli congratulated General Jashari for his leadership and at the same time reiterated that the US will continue to support the KSF in the development of military and defense capabilities.
