Within the official visit to Israel, Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj was hosted in a meeting with Minister of Intelligence of Israel, Elazar Stern.

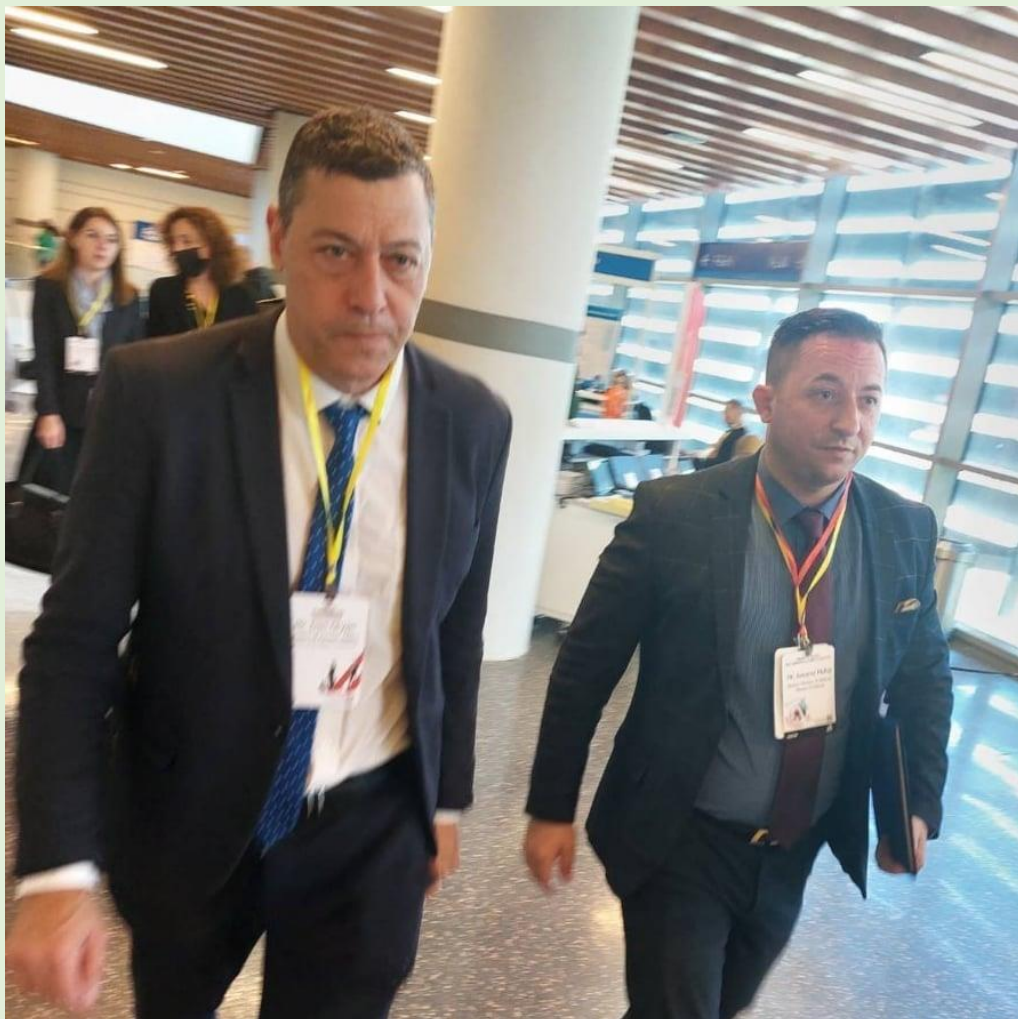


On this occasion he has thanked and expressed deep gratitude for Israeli state for general support given to our country as well as readiness for provision of support also in the defense and security field.

NETHERLANDS AN IMPORTANT PARTNER IN THE DEFENCE AND SECURITY FIELD

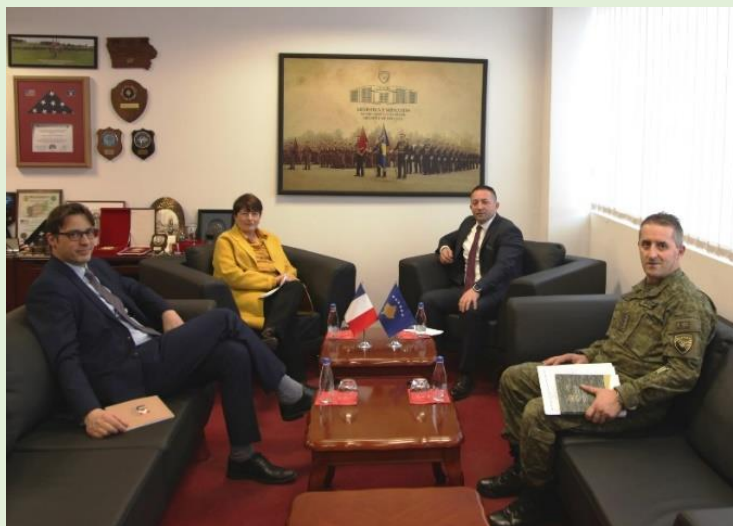

When a minister of a government of a state that aspires to the European Union honors and glorifies the deeds of a criminal, it should be an alarm for the policy-making and decision-making circles of the EU and the entire western democratic world. This is his next orchestrated provocation, which means a threat to Kosovo, Bosnia and Croatia and their people's victims of Milosevic's crime in Serbia, who, in addition to Vulin, has also been praised by the current President of Serbia, Vucic.

Western peace, security, stability, and democracy are dim with such primitive, inhuman, and anti-civilizational mindsets and approaches. This diabolical approach does not bother the Republic of Kosovo and its people who never forget, because its Freedom and Independence are already a powerful reality, and that the state of Kosovo naturally stands on the basis of Euro-Atlantic values. It is the last moment to line up on the right side of history, to apologize, to condemn Serbian criminals, as well as not to live with false myths and minds sick of hatred.

DART is the first disaster response team before the main response team that arrives at the scene. The relevant training for the staff of the International Training Center for Search and Rescue of the KSF (ITCSR) was conducted with a similar scenario for the first response to the disaster. On this occasion, UKISAR introduced the Certificate of Recognition for ICRC, one of the final steps in obtaining international accreditation of ICRC as a search and rescue training center worldwide.
