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MINISTRY OF DEFENSE AND KSF CONTINUE TO HAVE STRONG SUPPORT FROM THE USA

The Deputy Commander of the United States European Command (EUCOM), Lieutenant General Michael L. Howard and his delegation were hosted at the Ministry of Defense in April. The main objective of the Ministry of Defense for 2022/23 is the development of operational capabilities and capacities for the protection of the territorial integrity, independence, and state sovereignty of our country.



MINISTER MEHAJ AT THE “ISOA 2022” CONFERENCE



Upon the invitation of the International Association of US Stability Operations, Minister Mehaj, accompanied by the Deputy Commander of the KSF, Major General Enver Cikaqi, participated in the Conference “ISOA 2022”, organized in Stuttgart, Germany. In his speech, held at this conference, Minister Mehaj said that this is a great way to get to know each other, exchange ideas and opinions and understand each other's views. Speaking about the security situation in Europe and in the world, Minister Mehaj said that the destabilizing security situation in Russia and Ukraine affects Europe and the Balkans. He further stressed that as a free and democratic country, Kosovo strongly supports Ukraine and condemns Russia's occupation of Ukraine. “We stand by committed to our partners and the values of democracy. The main goal of our country is membership in NATO and the EU “, said Minister Mehaj. At the end of the speech, Minister Mehaj stressed that Kosovo has created 10 free economic zones that offer favorable geographical location, favorable business environment, lower operating costs, ready-to-use infrastructure, rental of business premises and other favorable conditions.

“For this reason, I invite each of you to visit Kosovo and see the potential for investment and opportunities for cooperation,” said Minister Mehaj.

During this conference, Minister Mehaj, in addition to his presentation at the conference sessions, will also meet with prominent US military personalities, leaders of well-known companies in the US defense industry, experts, etc.

During the three days of the conference “ISOA 2022”, held in Germany, in addition to discussions on the security situation in the region and the world, Minister Mehaj presented in panels and separate meetings the potential and economic opportunities offered by the Republic of Kosovo for investments to various companies, especially in the defense industry. He also stressed that the preparations for the establishment of the Defense Agency is in function of these investments, creating an easy communication between investors and the country. He further added that other facilities create important geographical and strategic position, road infrastructure and modern international airport that offers easy access to regional and world markets, 0% export tax, etc. He also mentioned the fact that the Republic of Kosovo has a young population, where almost 2/3 of the population in Kosovo is of working age.



TRANSFER OF THE AUTHORITY OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE NATO (NALT) ADVISORY AND LIAISON TEAM

In April, a special ceremony was held regarding the transfer of authority of the NATO Advisory and Liaison Team Director (NALT).
