THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE KLA EPOPEE (EPIC) WAS CELEBRATED AT "ADEM JASHARI" BARRACKS



The nationwide celebration, in honor of the 25th anniversary of the "KLA Epopee" on March 5, 6 and 7 and in memory of the death of the legendary Commander Adem Jashari, the Jashari Family and all the nation's martyrs who fell for freedom, was held in the "Adem Jashari" Barracks. At this event, KSF forces were reviewed by state leaders

including the President of the Republic of Kosovo, Vjosa Osmani, the Prime Minister Albin Kurti, the Speaker of the Assembly, Glauk Konjufca, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, ministers of the Government of the Republic of Kosovo, senior officials of the Ministry of Interior, generals and senior military personnel of the KSF, as well as other local, international political, diplomatic and military authorities as well as citizens.

The President of the Republic of Kosovo, Vjosa Osmani, in her speech, emphasized that this freedom and this state bear the stamp of the legendary commander Adem Jashari, his family and the three thousand martyrs of the Kosovo Liberation Army and the thousands of fighters that we still have today.

While, Prime Minister Albin Kurti, in his speech, emphasized that the war raging in Prekaz encouraged the mobilization and unification of people around the Kosovo Liberation Army. These brave efforts managed to win the support of the NATO Alliance and especially





the USA, which then got involved in the war to deliver the final blow to Serbia and to liberate Kosovo in 1999.

Rifat Jashari, Head of Jashari's family, attended the ceremony "Epopée of the KLA", as a guest of honor was expressing respect for all the martyrs who fell for freedom. He said that he is proud that today he is in front of the Kosovo Army, which has been awaited for many generations.

On this occasion, Brigadier General Ralf Peter Hammerstein assumed the position of director of NALT from Brigadier General Joachim Hoppe, who has headed NALT since April 2022.

Guests included Prime Minister of Kosovo, Albin Kurti, Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, Dep/Minister Shemsi Sylaj,

Dep/Commander of the KSF, Major General Enver Cikaqi, senior officials and officers of the Ministry of Defense and NALT, and many others.



Also, present at this ceremony was the current Chief of Operations, Operations Division of the NATO General Staff, Ariella Viehe.

In his speech, Prime Minister Kurti, among other things, emphasized that the NATO Advisory and Liaison Team in the Ministry of Defense and the KSF enables us to maintain our current security and ensure a future towards the Partnership for Peace and NATO membership.

Prime Minister Kurti added that the support from NALT and in particular from General Hoppe, in the drafting of the three basic laws of the Ministry of Defense and the KSF, the establishment of the parliamentary commissioner for the KSF and the close



cooperation in improving the recruitment process was decisive for effective improvement of civilian democratic oversight of the Force. The Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, in his speech said that General Hoppe's contribution to the Ministry of Defense and the KSF is a proof of his leadership, expertise and commitment to the values and principles of NATO. Minister Mehaj added that his efforts have helped strengthen Kosovo's security and stability, contributing to the overall security of the region and the wider international community. While the outgoing director of NALT, Brigadier General Joachim Hoppe said that it has been a great honor to represent NATO here in Kosovo and that he feels proud of the work that NATO and his team have done in advising security organizations in Kosovo.

On his part, the new director of NALT, Brigadier General Ralf Peter Hammerstein expressed his gratitude for the warm welcome in Kosovo and emphasized that he will maintain NALT's support for security organizations in Kosovo by continuing to build on the efforts of his predecessor.

At this ceremony, the Chief of Current Operations, NATO HQ, Operations Division, Ariella Viehe decorated General Hoppe with NATO medals.

General Hoppe was also decorated with the medal for "Outstanding Service" by Minister Mehaj as well as with the medal for "Selfless Service" by the Deputy Commander of the KSF, Major General Enver Cikaqi.

DIRECTIVE ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLANNING, PROGRAMMING, BUDGETING AND EXECUTION POLICY

The Directive for the implementation of the Policy on Planning, Programming, Budgeting and Execution was signed in the Ministry of Defense in March, as an essential strategic document for the development of the institutional capacities of defense in a long-term period. This document was drafted after a detailed analysis between the Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force, supported by the American Embassy, US Deputy Chief of Mission Alyson Grunder and Planning Advisor Joe Duncan as part of the Global Defense Reform Program.

The document in question has seven main pillars and forty-one objectives which directly support the implementation of the Comprehensive Transition Plan, thus building and improving defense management systems.

The Ministry of Defense and the KSF are developing with the continuous aim of not only guaranteeing the security of citizens and territorial defense, but also fulfilling the objective of being a significant member of the NATO alliance.



BILATERAL MILITARY PLAN 2023 BETWEEN KOSOVO AND JORDAN HAS BEEN SIGNED



The signing of the bilateral Plan for 2023 between Kosovo and Jordan took place in March, on the occasion of the official visit to Jordan of the Director of the Department for International Cooperation and Euro-Atlantic Integrations of the Ministry of Defense, Colonel Sylejman Cakaj and Major Mentor Ibrahimi..

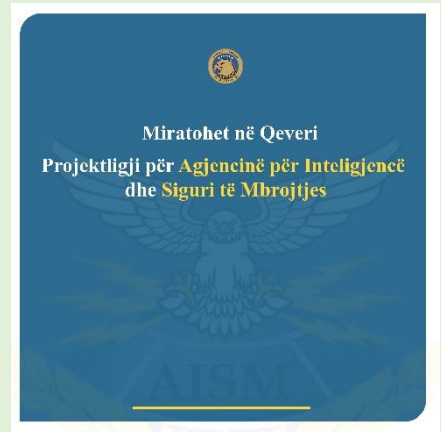

At the 136th meeting of the Government of the Republic of Kosovo, the Draft Law for the Defense Intelligence and Security Agency was approved, thus marking an important step in the field of defense and security of the country.

This agency will exercise its activity inside and outside the territory of the Republic of Kosovo with the aim of supporting the Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force in the field of intelligence, counter-intelligence and security related to threats or possible risks for conducting their constitutional and legal mission.

The Kosovo Security Force is a force that aims to serve in NATO, and at a high level of skill and preparation!



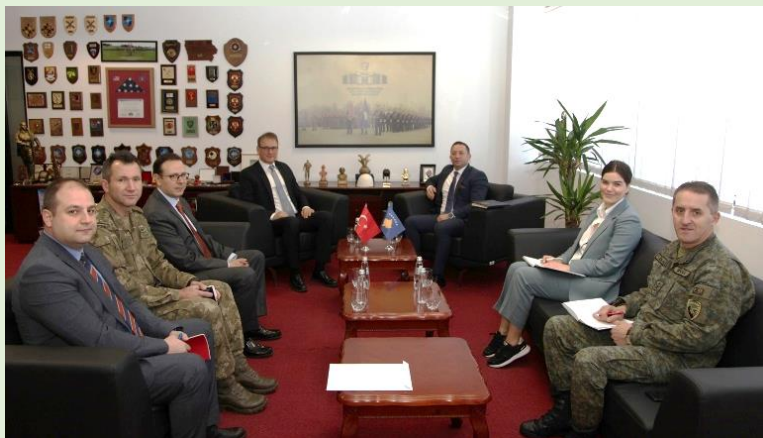
2023-YEAR OF THE RESTRUCTURING OF THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE

The Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, and the Minister of the Environment, Spatial Planning and Infrastructure, Liburn Aliu, held a press conference regarding the strategic million-dollar projects that are being realized in the former Gjakova Airport and in Babaj i Bokes.



Minister Aliu spoke about the procedures followed for the expropriation of properties planned for the realization of these two projects of national interest, very important from a strategic point of view for the Ministry of Defense, namely for the needs of the Kosovo Security Force.

Minister Aliu emphasized that the amount paid for the expropriation of these properties amounts to over 9 million euros, while all expropriated properties have already been transferred in the name of the Republic of Kosovo.

Meanwhile, Minister Mehaj spoke about the importance of these two projects in the development of the Kosovo Security Force, the functional purpose of which will contribute directly to the advancement of the professional training capacities of the Kosovo Army, thus making other steps towards the fulfillment of NATO military standards.
