At the invitation of the United States Army Association (AUSA), the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, together with the commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, participated in the Annual Defense Industry Conference and Fair in October AUSA 2022” in Washington.

At the "AUSA 2022" Exposition, Minister Mehaj and General Jashari met with representatives of the well-known manufacturing companies of the American Defense industry, and were informed of the latest technological developments in this field, through informative presentations as well as panel discussion on the field of defense and security.

The participation of the representatives of the Republic of Kosovo, reaffirms the strong faith that our allies have in our western democratic values and our state capacities for engagement on the common front in the defense of peace, freedom and democracy, as well as in the service of global stability and security.



MINISTER MEHAJ RECEIVED THE PRINCIPAL DIRECTOR FOR EUROPE AND NATO POLICY OF THE AMERICAN DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, ANDREW L. WINTERNITZ



The Minister of Defense Armend Mehaj hosted the Principal Director for Europe and NATO Policy of the US Department of Defense, Andrew L. Winternitz, accompanied by the official of the Office of the US Secretary of Defense, Erica Simon, and the US Defense Attaché. Colonel Darrick Mosley, with whom they discussed the security situation in the country and the region and the current potential challenges from factors threatening peace and general stability.

On this occasion, Mr. Winternitz, praised the achievements of the Ministry of Defense and the KSF, with special emphasis on the support of the US-led NATO humanitarian operation for the evacuation of Afghans, as well as the logistical support of operations to support Ukraine.

In this regard, the General Inspector of the KSF, Major General Irfete Spahiu, in her speech addressed to the audience addressed the topic "Women's Contribution in the Army", stressing that the contribution of women in the army is not a quota that must be fulfilled but it is seen as an added military value, but also day by day as a necessity for operational success.

During the three-day seminar, the challenges and the future perspective for the Western Balkans in a changing European security environment, NATO's support for peace and stability in the region, governance and reform of the security sector in Kosovo, as well as parliamentary oversight on security institutions in Kosovo.

The Assembly of the Republic of Kosovo and the NATO Parliamentary Assembly organized the 102nd Rose Roth traditional seminar in October. One of the topics that was examined in this seminar was the topic "Euro-Atlantic integration of the Western Balkans, long-term challenges, new realities and future perspectives", where Minister Mehaj presented one of the main speeches in these sessions. In the speech His Excellency, Minister Mehaj, informed the participants of his strategic objectives in the development and advancement of the KSF, his goals in the field of defense diplomacy, international cooperation and engagement in the Euro-Atlantic integration processes of the Republic of Kosovo and its Government.

THE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY OF NATO VISITED THE KSF

During their stay in Kosovo, the participants of the 102nd Rose-Roth seminar of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly, headed by the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly, Ruxandra Popa, visited the Doctrine and Training Command of the Kosovo Security Force in Ferizaj. They were received by the Chief of Staff of the KSF, Brigadier General Jeton Dreshaj, accompanied by the Deputy Commander of the KDS, Colonel Mehmet Lladrovci. On this occasion, General Dreshaj presented to the audience the vision and achievements of the KSF, and discussed the challenges and threats in the region and beyond, as well as the achievements of the KSF based on the 10-year transition plan, the creation of capacities defense with the new mandate of the KSF.

DEPUTY MINISTER SYLA HOSTED THE DEPUTY ASSISTANT TO THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF NATO, BURCU SAN

The Deputy Minister of Defense, Shemsi Sylja, accompanied by the Inspector General of the KSF, Major General Irfete Spahiu, hosted in a meeting the new appointee to the position Deputy Assistant to the Secretary General of NATO, Burcu San, accompanied by the director of NALT, Brigadier General Joachim Hoppe.

In this meeting, they talked about the general situation in the country, region and beyond, the Comprehensive Transition Plan of the KSF, international cooperation, the integration of non majority –community and the increase in the number of women and girls in the KSF. The Deputy Assistant to the General Secretary of NATO, Burcu San, emphasized that she is satisfied with the progress achieved in the development of the Ministry of Defense and KSF and with the good cooperation with KFOR.



KSF AND ARMY OF NORTH MACEDONIA HAVE MANY OPPORTUNITIES FOR COOPERATION



In the framework of bilateral cooperation, in October, Minister Mehaj met the Minister of Defense of North Macedonia, Slavjanka Petrovska.

On this occasion, the two ministers discussed the areas in which we can cooperate, with special emphasis on cooperation in training and joint exercises between the armies of the two countries.

Also, Minister Mehaj reminded his counterpart, Minister Petrovska, that the KSF is ready to offer training to the North Macedonian army in the field of search and rescue, for which we have extremely prepared capacities, while the North Macedonian side will exchange with us the experience of internal reformation along the journey in the process for membership in the Partnership for Peace Program, in which we aim for the Republic of Kosovo to be a member.

Also important discussions were the agreement on cooperation in the process of integrating women into the army, the exchange of the most successful practices, the education of female officers and their training, as well as other issues of common interest.

THE SECURITY STRATEGY OF KOSOVO FOR THE YEARS 2022-2027 APPROVED BY PARLIAMENT

In the Assembly of the Republic of Kosovo, on October 24, the Kosovo Security Strategy was presented, through which strategic document direction is given to our institutions in the unification of policies that will have a direct impact on the security of every citizen and the maintainance of peace in general.

The continuous investment in the KSF through the increase of the budget by more than 52%, has enabled the supply of modern weapons as well as the advancement in the professional training of our soldiers, while the implementation of this document will increase even more our defense capacities and vigilance as it concerns the security situation in our country but also beyond these borders, because our strategic goal is membership in NATO and the EU.

Coordination between institutions, the contribution of citizens to the Security Fund, together with the support of our strategic allies, are the unparalleled synergy for concrete results, a democratic, secure and capable state to guarantee the people's well-being and to contribute to peacekeeping missions everywhere.



KOSOVO AND GERMANY ARE AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF BILATERAL DEFENSE COOPERATION



The Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj and the Commander of the KSF, General Jashari in October welcomed the German Deputy Chief of Defense, General of the Bundeswehr, and Lieutenant General Markus Laubenthal with his delegation, where they informed him about the security situation in our country and region, then for the development processes in the Ministry of Defense and KSF, with a focus on the dynamics of the implementation of the second phase of the transition, simultaneously seeking the further advancement of

Every day, the Kosovo Security Force is showing a high level of professional preparation through the successes they are achieving in various international competitions. Recently, the Kosovo Security Force team managed to get the silver medal in one of the most prestigious military competitions in the world 'Cambrian Patrol 22' which took place in Great Britain.

In this competition, KSF members showed exceptional performance during 48 hours of training in the Black Mountains of Wales, together with 80 British teams and 27 teams from other international countries. The KSF's performance has also been praised by the United Kingdom's Defense Adviser, Lt. Col. John Hunter, as a clear demonstration of the commitment and high standards that the KSF has met.



COMPANY 1A OF THE FIRST REGIMENT OF THE KSF LAND FORCES DEMONSTRATED HIGH PROFESSIONALISM IN THE LIVE FIRE FIELD EXERCISE



In the framework of the exercise plan of the KSF units, in October the KSF members from the 1st Regiment, Company 1A carried out the field exercise with operational firing (LFX), held in Babaj of Boka. This final demonstration with the "Company on the attack" scenario was demonstrated with high professionalism. The exercise was carried out over a period of more than three weeks, where during this period firing with live ammunition was carried out at the team, squad, platoon and company level, including firing with all infantry weapons, calibers from 5.56 mm to 40 mm.

The demonstration was followed closely by the Chief of Staff of the KSF, Brigadier General Jeton Dreshaj, the military advisor to the Minister of Defense, Colonel Hamdi Pollomi, deputy. Commander of the Land Forces Command, Colonel Hysen Dreshaj, as well as other KSF Officers and Non-commissioned officers.



DIRECTOR OF DEFENSE POLICY, FARUK GECI ATTENDS THE ADRIATIC CHARTER ANNUAL MEETING, USA-A5



Under the chairmanship of the Ministry of Defense of Montenegro, in OCTOBER the annual meeting of the initiative, the Adriatic Charter, US-A5, was held at the level of the directors of defense policies.

In this meeting, the Ministry of Defense was represented by the director of the Directorate for Defense Policy, Faruk Geci.

The main focus of the meeting was the concept of the revitalization of the Adriatic Charter as well as the level of regional cooperation within this initiative.

In his presentation, Director Geci reconfirmed the commitment of the Republic of Kosovo, respectively the Ministry of Defense to provide the full contribution within the framework of regional cooperation in the field of security and defense as well as reiterated the

request for membership with full status of Kosovo in this initiative.

Among other things, in this meeting, the majority of member states of the Adriatic Charter re-enforced the Open Door policy of this initiative, and within it the request for membership of the Republic of Kosovo in this initiative.

According to the concept and format of the Adriatic Charter, USA-A5, the next meetings will continue at the level of defense ministers and foreign ministers in November and December of this year.

Also, General Spahiu recalled that despite the stereotypes, starting from her example and that of her KSF military colleagues, women can overcome operational challenges, achieve treatment and equal opportunities to achieve effectiveness, alongside their male colleagues, to treat security challenges.

Under the organization of the President of the Republic of Kosovo, Vjosa Osmani, the forum "Women, Peace, Security" was held, with the theme "Agenda for Women, Peace and Security, under the constant light of changes in the security architecture".

Minister Mehaj, who was present at this conference, emphasized that the integration of women in the security sector is undoubtedly an important issue, because it is an illusion to believe that we will have stable stability without the involvement of half the population, without the involvement of women.

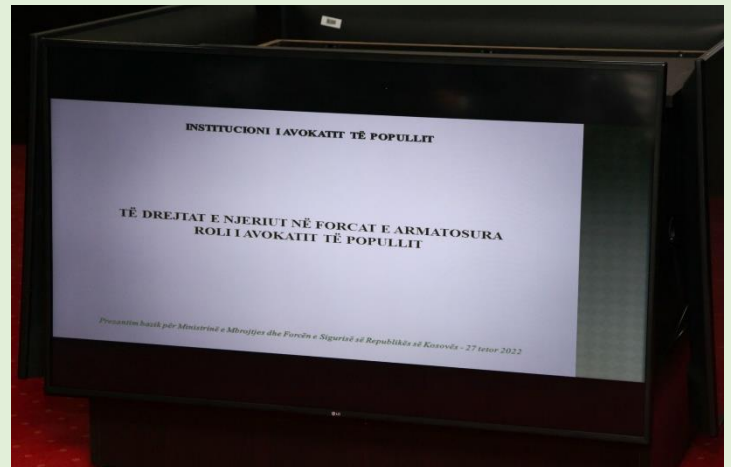
