KSF and Partners 2024-United for Defense

The Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force (KSF) held the annual international conference “KSF and Partners 2024”, the 16th in a row. This conference, held in Pristina, brought together senior representatives of the Ministry of Defense and the KSF, ambassadors, defense attachés of the Republic of Kosovo, as well as other diplomatic representatives and military

attachés from Kosovo’s partner states. In their speeches, Deputy Minister of Defense Shemsi Sylja and KSF Commander Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari emphasized the importance of international cooperation and the role of the KSF in maintaining peace and security in the



region. Brigadier General Christian Nawrat, Director of the NATO Advisory and Liaison Team (NALT), praised the progress of the KSF and its commitment to international defense standards. The British Ambassador to Kosovo, Jonathan Hargreaves, the Turkish Ambassador to Kosovo, Sabri Tunç Angili, and the Italian Ambassador to Kosovo, Antonello De Riu, also delivered speeches expressing their support for the KSF and the importance of close partnership with Kosovo. During the conference, thematic presentations were given by the Chief of Staff of the KSF General Staff, Brigadier General Ilir Qeriqi, Colonel Bekim Osmani, Colonel Astrit Haliti, Lieutenant Colonel Beton Retkoceri, the Defense Attaché of the Republic of Croatia, Colonel Stjepan Domjancic and Major Shpëtim Ujkani. These presentations addressed various issues related to security and defense, including new strategies and improvements in KSF capabilities.



The “KSF and Partners 2024” conference served as an important platform for the exchange of ideas and experiences between international partners and the KSF, further strengthening ties and cooperation in the field of defense and security. The KSF and Partners Conference is a prestigious annual event that has been held annually since 2014. This conference is organized by the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Kosovo, with the aim to enhance the bilateral and multilateral cooperation in the field of defense and security. The participants on this conference are representatives from Ministries of Defense of our partner countries, Defense Attaches accredited to the Republic of Kosovo, and representatives of the international missions and organizations in the Republic of Kosovo.



On the second day of the international conference "KSF and Partners 2024," Deputy Minister of Defense, Shemsi Sylaj, welcomed the KSF Defense Attachés, valuing their work and commitment in representing the KSF and the Republic of Kosovo in the countries where they are stationed. It was a shared assessment that the conference was a joint success of the Ministry of Defense, the KSF, and our international partners.

Strategic Meetings of Minister Maqedonci and Prime Minister Kurti in Warsaw

Defense Minister Ejup Maqedonci and Prime Minister Albin Kurti held a series of important meetings during the Warsaw Security Forum. They met with U.S. Assistant Secretary of Defense Celeste Wallander and Ambassador Michael Carpenter, where they emphasized the importance of Kosovo's membership in NATO and the Adriatic Charter for maintaining regional security. Minister Maqedonci highlighted that the partnership between the United States and Kosovo is unwavering, and that Kosovo is ready to contribute to security matters alongside its strategic partners.

Also, minister Maqedonci and Prime Minister Kurti expressed their gratitude to American congressman, Jason Crow, for his continuous support for Kosovo and discussed Kosovar diaspora importance in USA as a very important bridge between two countries and their contribution in American society. In a meeting with Defense Minister of Estonia, Hanno Pevkur, willingness for cooperation was reconfirmed in the field of security, to maintain the stability and peace in the region and beyond. Minister Maqedonci stressed the Estonias importance of support for building defense capacities of Kosovo as a trusted partner of western countries.

At the end Minister Maqedonci and Prime Minister Kurti developed a bilateral meeting with Deputy Prime Minister of Poland, Krzysztof Gawkowski, simultaneously Minister of Digital Affairs. They discussed the interstate relations, Russian aggression in Ukraine, Kosovo's help for Ukranian people, and the potenicial cooperation with Poland in the section of Technology. Also, they discussed for the preparations and importance of cooperation between two countries during the Polish Presidency of the European Union Council in the first half of 2025.



Kosovo Security Forces Earn Silver at World-Renowned Cambrian Patrol 2024

The Kosovo Security Force team managed to rank second, being awarded silver medals in the “Cambrian Patrol 2024” competition in the United Kingdom. They competed among 111 teams, including 37 international teams from 36 different countries. The “Cambrian Patrol” is one of the most challenging competitions in the world, where teams go through rigorous military tasks for tactical preparation. These tasks include facing CBRN threats, medical operations, inspection and discovery of forces, attacks, navigating minefields, crossing water obstacles, artillery limits, and dealing with prisoners. The Kosovo Security Forces participated with a regiment team from the Third Infantry of the Ground Forces Command, demonstrating extraordinary engagement and high professionalism throughout the competition.

In this meeting, they discussed various themes related to security, challenges, achievements, and the cooperation of



Kosovo with NATO through the Advisory and Liaison Team of the alliance. During the meeting, Minister Maqedonci emphasized that the Republic of Kosovo has offered two military packages to support Ukraine. Through the participation of the Kosovo Security Forces in the Interflex mission and the Demining Coalition, Kosovo is actively contributing to training Ukrainian troops in their fight against the Russian aggressor. “We are determined to implement the General Transition Plan and we have a very clear path towards NATO membership, where shared values unite us with our partner countries,” emphasized Minister Maqedonci.

Minister Maqedonci Hosted Commander of Allied Joint Force Command in Naples and New KFOR Commander



The Defense Minister, Ejup Maqedonci, hosted the Commander of the Allied Joint Forces of NATO in Naples, Admiral Stuart B. Munsch, accompanied by the new Commander of KFOR, Major General Enrico Barduani. Minister Maqedonci congratulated Major General Barduani on his new assignment and expressed the unwavering commitment of the Ministry of Defense to cooperate and coordinate in the field of

security and defense, to maintain peace and stability in the country. On this occasion, he emphasized the strategic goal of Kosovo's membership in the NATO alliance. "We believe that Kosovo can contribute alongside partner states, which would help establish stable peace in the Western Balkans," said Minister Maqedonci.

Enhanced Medical Cooperation Protocol Signed Between Kosovo and Türkiye

With this occasion, the revised cooperation protocol in the field of medical treatment was signed between the two ministries, enabling additional quotas for the treatment of KSF soldiers in Turkish military medical institutions. Additionally, the agreement allows for joint exercises in the field of military medicine, medical training before military deployments, exchange of medical personnel, and professional education for

KSF members at the Turkish Military Medical Academy in general medicine, dentistry, nursing, and pharmacy. Over 300 soldiers of the Kosovo Security Force have been treated free of charge in specialized Turkish military health institutions as part of bilateral cooperation in this field. The Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Kosovo is deeply grateful to the Republic of Türkiye for their unwavering and continuous support.

The Defense Ministers of Kosovo and Albania Discuss Development of Joint Military Capacities



In October, the Defense Minister of Kosovo, Ejup Maqedonci, made an official visit to Tirana, where he was received with high honors by his counterpart, the Defense Minister of Albania, Pirro Vengu. During this warm and fraternal meeting, they discussed deepening and expanding cooperation in the field of defense and military education. Both ministers acknowledged that this cooperation will continue even more

intensely in the field of defense. They emphasized the opportunity to expand the involvement of students and officers from the Kosovo Security Force (KSF) in Albanian military education institutions, as well as the support and development of joint capacities, including in the field of civil emergencies. Additionally, they highlighted the continuation of Albania's support for Kosovo's aspirations for integration into the Euro-Atlantic family.

Among other things, he mentioned that the ties between the two armies have been strengthened through joint training and exercises. He stressed, “Joint training and exercises, the education of cadets from both countries in the military academies of Kosovo and Albania, and cooperation in many other areas, besides influencing the exchange of knowledge, are also helping to build the interpersonal relationships among our soldiers.”

Minister of Defense Ejup Maqedonci, at the invitation of the Minister of Defense of Albania, Pirro Vengu, took part in the ceremony marking the beginning of the new academic year at the Academy of Armed Forces of Albania, where 10 cadet students from the Kosovo Security Force (KSF) have started their studies. In this ceremony, the minister emphasized the importance of cooperation between Kosovo and Albania in the military field.

Additionally, the discussion touched on investment in the defense industry, with realizable projects expected to materialize soon, which is important news for the country. Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, Commander of the KSF, also attended the meeting. He thanked Minister Güler for Türkiye 's continuous support of the Kosovo Security Force.

The meeting also covered the good cooperation between the two partner states, particularly between the KSF and the Armed Forces of the Republic of Türkiye , and the further continuation of joint development efforts.

In conclusion, both ministers pledged to continue their cooperation as contributors to peace in the region and beyond.

During this visit, in a separate meeting, the KSF Commander, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, hosted the Chief of



General Staff of the Turkish Armed Forces, General Metin Gurak. General Jashari expressed his deep gratitude for the continuous support that the Armed Forces of the Republic of Türkiye continue to provide the training and professionalization of military personnel, as well as the support for the Kosovo Security Force.

KSF Commander also spoke about capacity building and the achievements of the Force, joint bilateral plans in the context of training, education, joint activities, as well as the possibility of exchanging experiences with the aim of increasing capabilities of the soldiers of the Kosovo Security Force. Both Generals agreed on the continuation and further affirmation of bilateral cooperation in the field of defense.



Kosovo and Türkiye Strengthen Defense Cooperation at SAHA EXPO



Defense Minister Ejup Maqedonci, invited by the National Defense Minister of the Republic of Türkiye, Yaşar Güler, and the President of SAHA Istanbul, Haluk Bayraktar, attended the main event of the Turkish defense and aerospace industry, SAHA EXPO, in October. The minister was accompanied by the defense attaché in Türkiye, Colonel Bekim Zejnullahu, and the Director of the Logistics and Infrastructure Department in the Defense Ministry, Colonel Imer Avdiu. Participation in this event offered an excellent opportunity to initiate contacts and cooperation in the field of defense and security through bilateral meetings.

During the official stay in Türkiye,

Minister Maqedonci met with Haluk Bayraktar, who hosted SAHA EXPO, and learned about Bayraktar Company's innovations in the field of unmanned aerial vehicles and other military and civil systems. They agreed to continue cooperation and explore new opportunities of mutual interest. The Defense Ministry and the Kosovo Security Forces have already established strategic and operational cooperation with Bayraktar Company, strengthening their combat capacities.

Minister Maqedonci also held a bilateral meeting with the Defense Minister of Somalia, Abdulkadir Mohamed Nur, where he informed him about the development of defense capacities and expressed the readiness of the Republic of Kosovo to contribute to global security. They planned the joint deployment with the Turkish Armed Forces in Somalia, an initiative previously discussed with the Turkish Defense Minister during his visit to Kosovo. Minister Nur supported this initiative and expressed his gratitude. Additionally, Minister Maqedonci met with the head of the Defense Industry Agency of Türkiye and manufacturers of military systems, where he was informed about the latest innovations in the defense industry and aerospace sector. The minister emphasized that Turkish manufacturers of weapons systems have been and will remain the primary sources for the purchase of weapons for the Republic of Kosovo, as Kosovo and Türkiye are allies and strategic partners in defense and security.



Official Visit of the Minister Maqedonci to Qatar – Cooperation and New initiatives in the Defense Industry



The Defense Minister, Ejup Maqedonci, has traveled for an official visit to the State of Qatar. In the first day of his visit, he was hosted from the executive director of Qatar Military Industry – Barzan Company, Abdullah Hasan Al-Khater. During the meeting, they discussed about the numerous opportunities for cooperation in the field of defense industry, including the possibility of joint investments in the field of production. Minister Maqedonci was introduced to Qatar's products and had the opportunity to meet managers of various companies.

In a special meeting, Minister Maqedonci was hosted by the

Deputy Prime Minister and the Defense Minister of Qatar, Khalid bin Mohammed Al Attiyah. Minister Maqedonci expressed his gratitude for the support from the state of Qatar for his personal commitment to deepening relations. They discussed the security situation in Europe, especially in the Western balkans, and the development of the defense capacities of the Republic of Kosovo. In the meeting, they agreed on the establishment of cooperation bridges in the field of defense and the field of training, and military education, as well as the possibility of joint investment in the field of military production. Minister Al Attiyah offered 6 quotas for the education of cadets from Kosovo in Qatar's military academies, including the Qatar Airforce Academy. Minister Maqedonci visited „Al Zaeem Mohammed Bin Abdullah Al Attiya“ Airforce Academy in Qatar, where he was hosted with an official ceremony by General Brigader Salem Abdullah Al-Dassori. During the meeting, he was informed about the educational program that the Academy offers and visited the training facilities of the Academy. The Qatar Airforce Academy offers cadet training opportunities in the field of helicopter, fighter jet, transport aircraft and drones. Six cadets from Kosovo were confirmed to join the educational programe in this Academy.

At the end of the official visit to Qatar, Minister Maqedonci visited the „Joana Bin Jassim“ Academy for Defense Studies. He was hosted by General Major Fahd bin Mubarak Al-Khayarin, President of the Academy, where mid level and senior officers are trained for strategic tasks in the field of defense and security.





Minister Maqedonci held a lecture on the strategic security environment for global and regional threats, talking about Kosovo's journey and current development in the field of defense. The central focus was the role of political and military leadership in the face of modern security challenges. Minister Maqedonci also visited „Ahmet Bin Mohammed“ Military Academy in Qatar, where he was hosted with a high military ceremony by General Brigader Ali Mohammed Al Fadala. During the visit, he was informed about the military and academic program of the Academy and visited the training facilities. The possibility to send the cadets from Kosovo to attend the military educational program at this academy was confirmed, with all expenses covered by the State of Qatar.



Also, as part of their visit, the Minister together with The President Of the Republic of Kosovo Vjosa Osmani visited the Global Exhibition and Conference for National Security and Public Safety, Milipol Qatar. This event stands out for the presentation of the newest innovative products and services in the field of defense and public safety, which are also produced in accordance with NATO standards.



General Jashari Participated in AUSA 2024 to Enhance Defense Cooperation



At the invitation of the Association of United States Army (AUSA), the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, participated in the Annual Conference and Fair of the Defense Industry "AUSA 2024" in Washington DC, USA. Initially, General Jashari met with the Chief of Staff of the US Army, General Randy A. George, where they discussed bilateral cooperation between the two armies, joint exercises, and other joint activities. Minister Maqedonci Hosted Senior American Adviser for PPBE Implementation, Ronald Wilkins

In the meeting, they discussed the way forward for the implementation of this system, which is applied in the US Department of Defense. Minister Maqedonci emphasized that the implementation of the PPBE system in the Defense Ministry and the Kosovo Security Force has made significant progress in recent months. "The support of the USA for building the defense capacities of our country and strengthening civil supervision is instrumental in preparing our country for alignment with NATO," stressed Minister Maqedonci.

The PPBE regulation is an essential document for linking Defense Strategy resources and long-term objectives.



The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan has granted the application of Kosovo for the accreditation of a defense attaché of the Kosovo Security Forces. Another achieved objective during this year, the expansion of the diplomatic network of defense attaches is happening continuously.

KSF Certifies Fifth Group of Ukrainian Trainees



Within the framework of the assistance offered by Kosovo to support Ukraine in facing Russian aggression, today at the Deming Barracks in Prizren, the fifth group of trainees were certified. These trainees attended the EOD Level 1&2 training for six consecutive weeks, provided by instructors from the Demining Company of the Kosovo Security Force and American instructors from EUCOM. During these weeks, trainees were educated on explosive devices, specialized equipment, and work procedures to dispose of explosive devices as safely as possible.

Deputy Commander of the National Guard of the Kosovo Security Force, Colonel Skender Hoxha, congratulated the trainees on completing the training, emphasizing its importance and the noble role of their mission.

The group of trainees will return to Ukraine to contribute to their units in eliminating unexploded ordnance and reducing the risk to the Ukrainian people.

The Commander of the Kosovo Security Force hosted for a meeting the military medical delegation from Germany

The purpose of this visit was to increase and develop cooperation in the field of medicine, specifically military medicine, including the development of field medicine, field hygiene and sanitation (preventive medicine), and to review the development of joint training between the two armies.

In the framework of cooperation with the Turkish Teams (ETT) and the enhancement of infantry capacities, the Third Infantry Regiment has completed training with 81mm Mortars. This training aims to increase military capacities and interoperability in the field of fire support for the light infantry.



KSF Officer Graduates in Military Engineering



Captain Kemajl Haliti has successfully completed the "Engineering Captain's Career Course" at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, in the United States of America. The training aimed to prepare mid-level engineer officers with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively lead and manage engineer operations at the company and regimental levels. It focused on advanced engineering principles, tactical planning, military decision-making, and leadership development within the combat engineer context, preparing them for staff roles and command positions. Out of 75 officers, 16 were from countries such as Saudi Arabia, Benin, Brazil, Indonesia, Kosovo, South Korea, Germany, Ivory Coast, Tunisia, Italy, the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, Kuwait, and Lithuania. These 16 foreign officers were among the 75 student officers.

Regional Cooperation Strengthened Through SARITC Training



Soldiers from the Armed Forces of the Republic of Albania (AFRA) and the KSF have been trained and certified at the Search and Rescue International Training Centre (SARITC) of the Kosovo Security Force in the Basic and Advanced Urban Search and Rescue Courses. The purpose of the training is to prepare personnel with basic and advanced methods of Search and Rescue, using equipment to develop critical skills in urban disaster response. At the basic level, soldiers are prepared with foundational knowledge for search and rescue operations, assessment of buildings and structures, and presentation of rescue tools and techniques. At the advanced level, participants are trained in complex collapse scenarios, rescue in confined spaces, advanced rescue techniques, and tactical coordination between teams from different units. This training is a testament to the continuing commitment of the Search and Rescue International Training Centre (SARITC) to improve regional disaster response capabilities and strengthen military cooperation in search and rescue operations.

KSF NCO Certified in Germany
