NOVEMBER 27, DAY OF THE FORCE



The Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force marked November 27, the “Day of the Force” which was also the “Open Day” where many citizens and students from all the schools of the country were welcomed in all the barracks of the KSF, as in Pristina, Mitrovica, Istog, Gjilan, Prizren, Ferizaj and Pomezatin. On this festive day, equipment, weaponry, demonstrations and various activities were exhibited, which prove the capacities of the KSF.

The central manifestation was held in the barracks “Adem Jashari” in Pristina, where the highest state leaders participated, starting from the President of the Republic of Kosovo, Vjosa Osmani, the Prime Minister of the Republic of Kosovo, Albin Kurti, the Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci, The Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant

MINISTER MAQEDONCI PARTICIPATING IN THE SECURITY FORUM IN HALIFAX



The Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci, in November participated in the work of the International Security Forum in Halifax, Canada. This forum focuses on security issues that the North Atlantic Alliance and other countries that have embraced its common values are facing today. This year's Halifax Security Forum brought together around 300 international participants from the fields of security and defence, as well as politics, including former presidents, former prime ministers, defense ministers, defense chiefs, senators and parliamentarians from around the world.



- In the framework of this Forum, Minister Maqedonci held a meeting with the Minister of National Defense of Canada, Bill Blair. The two counterparts discussed issues related to current security challenges. Minister Maqedonci thanked his Canadian counterpart for the help given to Kosovo in all stages of state building, and expressed the will to deepen bilateral cooperation in the field of defense. The joint conclusion of the two ministers was that the bilateral cooperation in the field of defense and security between the two countries should be further deepened through the signing of a cooperation agreement.
- Also, the Minister Maqedonci has held bilateral meetings with the Minister of Defense of Estonia, Hanno Pevkur, as well as with the Minister of National Defense of Lithuania, Arvydas Anušauskas. In the meeting with his Estonian counterpart, cooperation in the field of security and defense and the possibility of signing a bilateral cooperation agreement in the future were discussed, among other things.
- Meanwhile, in the meeting with the Minister of Defense of Lithuania,



Arvydas Anušauskas, it was also discussed about joint efforts to provide



assistance to Ukraine within the demining coalition of the Contact Group for the Defense of Ukraine. They also agreed on the deepening of cooperation between the two countries in the field of defense, with special emphasis on the field of mutual education and training. In both meetings, minister Maqedonci received support for Kosovo's membership in the Euro-Atlantic structures.



■ On the second day of participation in the International Security Forum in Halifax, the Minister Maqedonci held a joint meeting with the group of Senators from the United States of America, Jeanne Shaheen from New Hampshire, Petter Welch from Vermont and Mike Rounds from Dakota South. Minister Maqedonci first expressed his gratitude for the irreplaceable contribution of the United States of America in all phases of the state-building of our country, as well as thanked the senators for their commitment in support of Kosovo. Among the topics discussed was the security situation in Kosovo, especially in the north of the country, after the events of the September 24 terrorist attack in Banjska, in which case the Minister Maqedonci

informed the senators about the findings after the said attack. The Minister expressed the position of the Republic of Kosovo that the political solution through dialogue is the best option for the normalization of relations between Kosovo and Serbia, while emphasizing that the international community must do more to demand responsibility from the destabilizing actors in the region.

- At the end of the second day of participation in the International Security Forum in Halifax, Canada, the Minister Maqedonci met the friend of Kosovo, the head of the foreign affairs committee of the United Kingdom parliament, Alicia Kearns. On this occasion, the minister thanked Mrs. Kearns for her unsparing commitment to present the truth about Kosovo and the threats that come to our country from organized terrorist and paramilitary structures, supported by the state institutions of Serbia. In this meeting, Mrs. Kearns pledged to maximize engagement and use her influence to support the Ministry of Defense and the Kosovo Security Force in building and developing defense capabilities.



MINISTER MAQEDONCI PARTICIPATED IN THE MEETING OF THE DEFENSE MINISTERS OF THE MEMBER COUNTRIES OF THE USA-ADRIATIC CHARTER (A5)



The meeting discussed the current security situation in the global arena, as well as the new challenges and security implications of the countries of our region and beyond.

Minister Maqedonci in his address emphasized the extraordinary importance of regional cooperation in order to face the new

security challenges, which come as a result of the malicious approach of regional and global actors. Also, he emphasized once again that the Republic of Kosovo expects a clearer and tougher reaction from the international community against the actions of terrorist groups supported by the state structures of Serbia, and emphasized the determination of the Government of the Republic of Kosovo and the security institutions to preserve of sovereignty and protection of territorial integrity of the country, always coordinating with international partners. At the end, the minister requested the support of the member countries for the full membership of the Republic of Kosovo in the US-Adriatic Charter (A5), as a regional initiative to open up opportunities for other regional initiatives and our Euro-Atlantic route.



THE MINISTER MAQEDONCI WAS HOSTED FOR A MEETING BY THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE OF THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY, GUIDO CROSETTO

The Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci, has been on an official visit to Italy in November, at the invitation of the Minister of Defense of the Republic of Italy, Guido Crosetto. During the meeting, the two ministers discussed the current situation in the Western Balkans, the importance of continued cooperation between the two states in the field of defense, to contribute to peace and stability in the Balkans and beyond. On this occasion, Minister

Maqedonci thanked Minister Crosetto for the support and contribution that Italy has given in Kosovo, through military and security forces, as part of KFOR and EULEX. In this meeting with his Italian counterpart, minister Maqedonci emphasized that Kosovo's goal is clear. *“Our commitment to join Euro-Atlantic organizations reflects the democratic, pro-Western values we embrace as a country. We are determined that alongside our strategic allies, Kosovo will be a guarantor of security in addition to its consumer”*, he emphasized.

- Within the framework of the official visit, the Minister of Defense was hosted in a meeting by the Chief of the Defense Staff of Italy and the future chairman of the NATO



Committee, Admiral Giuseppe Cavo Dragone. On this occasion, the parties discussed the current geopolitical situation, the development of the KSF, bilateral cooperation with Italy in the field of defense and our aim as a country for NATO and EU membership. The Minister Maqedonci thanked the Italian admiral for the excellent cooperation so far and for the continuous support that Italy has provided through KFOR and EULEX troops. For his part, the Admiral expressed high appreciation for the way the terrorist attack in the north of the country was managed, and also showed the will and full readiness to support Kosovo on the way to membership in the Partnership for Peace Program. Both agreed that maintaining

stability in the Balkans and beyond is a priority, while coordination with our strategic partners is the link that guarantees this.

GENERAL JASHARI MEETS THE CHIEF OF DEFENSE OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, GENERAL CARSTEN BREUER

The commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, together with the accompanying delegation from the KSF, were received in a working meeting at the Ministry of Defense in Berlin by the Chief of Defense of the Federal Republic of Germany, General Carsten Breuer. The two counterparts discussed the general security situation in Kosovo, the region and beyond, they also emphasized the



importance of increasing military cooperation between the armies of the two countries. Lieutenant General Jashari thanked his German counterpart for the continuous support that the German state and in particular the Bundeswehr has given and is giving to the development of the skills and capacities of the KSF. The two chiefs of defense agreed on the deepening of cooperation between the two countries and on this occasion General Jashari invited General Breuer for an official visit to Kosovo.



THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE AND KSF RECEIVED A DONATION FROM GERMANY

At the International Search and Rescue Center of the KSF in Pomezat, the ceremony of accepting and handing over the donation from the German state to the Ministry of Defense and the KSF was held. In this ceremony, the Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci and the commander of the National Guard of the KSF, Brigadier General Naim Haziri, accepts the donation from the German ambassador to Kosovo, Joern Rohde. This donation

worth about 500,000 euros includes two trucks for hazardous materials management operations. On this occasion, the Minister Maqedonci thanked Ambassador Rohde for the continuous support from the Federal Republic of Germany that he offers for the development of the Kosovo Security Force. For his part, Ambassador Rohde emphasized that the German state is interested in raising the institutional capacities of the Republic of Kosovo and the Ministry of Defense in particular. By the end of this year, it is expected that the donation received from the Federal Republic of Germany will reach the value of three million nine hundred thousand euros.





THE MINISTER MAQEDONCI AND GENERAL JASHARI HOSTED FOR A MEETING THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA, GENERAL KINGJI

In the meeting was discussed the current security situation, as well as the possibility of deepening bilateral cooperation between the forces of both countries in several military fields. On this occasion, Minister Maqedonci expressed deep gratitude to the Armed Forces of the Republic of Albania, for their special contribution to the development and advancement of the operational skills and capacities of the KSF, especially in the field of education and training. Also, he reiterated

the extraordinary importance of the support from the Ministry of Defense of the Republic of Albania and the AFROA, as a NATO member state, given the great experience in the Euro-Atlantic integration process, as well as in the establishment and development of military operationality in general. For his part, General Jashari thanked General Kingji for the visit and expressed his gratitude for the tireless efforts of Albania for the support given to the further development and advancement of the KSF and the alignment of the armies of both countries. Meanwhile, General Kingji in this meeting offered Albania's unconditional support for Kosovo's membership in regional initiatives. The interlocutors agreed to continue this close cooperation to guarantee the protection of national interests.

MINISTER EJUP MAQEDONCI HOSTED FOR A MEETING THE NEW AMBASSADOR OF ALBANIA, PETRIT MALAJ



The Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci, accompanied by the Deputy Minister Shemsi Sylja, welcomed the new ambassador of Albania to the Republic of Kosovo, Petrit Malaj, with whom he talked about the current developments in our country, the excellent relations between the two countries, but and the possibilities of deepening and concretizing them further in the field of defense. Congratulating Mr. Malaj on his new assignment at the head of the diplomatic mission of Albania in Pristina, Minister Maqedonci estimated that his

appointment to the position of ambassador will give a new impetus to this cooperation, which is of mutual interest to both countries. After thanking the ambassador for the institutional support so far, the Minister Maqedonci said that the intensification of bilateral relations between the two states, apart from the diplomatic aspect, is our obligation to the nation. For his part, the ambassador Malaj confirmed that he will be committed to strengthening cooperation between Tirana and Pristina.





ALBANIAN AIR FORCE OPENS DOORS FOR KOSOVO SECURITY FORCE PILOTS

In the framework of cooperation in the field of defense between Kosovo and Albania, KSF pilots have started to follow the theoretical and practical refresher program of helicopter flights at Farka Air Base, mandatory for crews to maintain flight reflexes. Minister Maqedonci expressed his gratitude for the willingness and commitment of his counterpart from Albania, Minister Niko Peleshi, to increase cooperation and support the KSF in building new capacities.

KSF AND AFRoA EXCHANGE THEIR EXPERIENCES

In the framework of the advancement of cooperation between the Kosovo Security Force and the Armed Forces of the Republic of Albania, a delegation of the KSF visited AFRoA. The delegation headed by Colonel Ahmet Ajeti, leader of the Doctrine Center at TRADOC, where he was received in separate meetings by the Acting Commander of the AFRoA Academy, Colonel Bardhyl Nuredinaj and by the Director of the Military Scientific Research Institute, Colonel Ulsi Rexhaj and the management staff of the Institute. During the two-day visit, experiences were exchanged and new areas of mutual cooperation were discussed between the two armies with a focus on the advancement of the professional development of soldiers in the training centers of the AFRoA and the KSF.



MINISTER MAQEDONCI DECORATED THE OWNER OF THE “BAYKAR” COMPANY, HALUK BAYRAKTAR, WITH A MEDAL FOR “DISTINGUISHED SERVICE”



The Minister of Defense, Ejup Maqedonci, accompanied by the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari and Deputy Minister Shemsi Syla, welcomed the owner of the “Baykar” company, Haluk Bayraktar, as well as the Ambassador of the Republic of Türkiye, Sabri Tunç Angili. He added that he is proud of the world-class skills being developed at Pomozatin, skills that are vital

to our country and our partners as we prepare for the roles that lie ahead of us in the global arena. Meanwhile, the deputy ambassador of the Netherlands, Roland Goldberg, expressed his gratitude for the hospitality of the Dutch search and rescue

team, who emphasized that this exercise is very useful for further cooperation between the two countries, in raising the capacities of both parties for building readiness to respond to emergency situations. Last year, the Search and Rescue Training Center of the KSF provided training for nearly 3,000 people, among whom, in addition to our citizens, hundreds of other foreign partners from Albania, Great Britain, Italy, Hungary, Jordan, Malta, North Macedonia, Northern Ireland, Portugal, Türkiye, Netherlands, etc.



DEPUTY MINISTER SYLA HOSTED FOR A MEETING THE MILITARY DELEGATION FROM THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF SWITZERLAND

In November, at the Ministry of Defense a visit was paid by a military delegation from Ministry of Defense of Switzerland, headed by Colonel Markus Schefer, and the commander of the recruitment of the Swiss Armed Forces, colonel Thomas Keller.
