MINISTER MEHAJ AND LIEUTENANT GENERAL JASHARI WITH DIGNIFIED REPRESENTATION IN FRONT OF ABOUT 50 STATES AT THE CONFERENCE OF THE UKRAINE DEFENSE CONTACT GROUP

At the General Staff of NATO in Brussels, the Minister of Defense Armend Mehaj and the Commander of the KSF Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, in June, together with the ministers and chiefs of defense of about 50 countries, participated in the monthly Conference of the Group of Defense Contact of Ukraine (UDCG).

Their participation was at the invitation of the US Secretary of Defense, Lloyd Austin III. On this occasion, Minister Mehaj, in his speech, emphasized the measures of the Republic of Kosovo against the Russian aggression in Ukraine, as well as the actions taken by the Government of the Republic of Kosovo are in function of



supporting the government and the Ukrainian people in their cause. Then, on the sidelines of the conference, Minister Mehaj together with General Jashari met Secretary Austin as well as the Commander of the American Command for Europe, who is also the Supreme Commander of NATO for Europe, 4-star General Tod D. Wolters.

In addition, they met many defense ministers and chiefs, such as Canada, the Netherlands, Albania, Croatia, Poland, Latvia, Montenegro, etc. This is the highest representation so far of the Minister of Defense and the Commander of the KSF, together, at the international defense level.



MINISTER MEHAJ PARTICIPATED IN THE FINAL EXECUTION OF MULTINATIONAL MILITARY EXERCISE "EFES' 2022" IN TURKEY

At the invitation of the Minister of National Defense of Turkey, Hulusi Akar, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, has participated in the Day of Distinguished Visitors in the largest military exercise of the Turkish armed forces with partner forces "EFES 2022". In this exercise, the KSF participated with a military contingent,



alongside 11,000 troops from 38 other countries around the world. Minister Mehaj and the Minister of National Defense of Turkey, Hulusi Akar, assessed that participation in such exercises is in line with the close cooperation between the two ministries and the forces, and both agreed to intensify further cooperation in the interest of peace, security, and stability in the region and beyond.

Minister Mehaj, among other things, thanked Minister Akar for the opportunity given as well as the support and continuous contribution to the development of the Ministry of Defense and the KSF. From his part, Minister Akar reiterated the readiness for the continuation of the open-handed support of the Republic of Turkey for the membership of the Republic of Kosovo in international security and regional defense organizations, in the Partnership for Peace Program for membership in NATO, as well as membership in the Council of Europe.



THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF TURKEY TOWARDS THE MODERNIZATION OF THE SYSTEMS AND EQUIPMENT OF THE KOSOVO SECURITY FORCE

The Commander of the Kosovo Security Force, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, at the invitation of his Turkish counterpart, the Chief of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Turkey, General Jashar Guler, during the month of June, made a three-day official visit to Turkey. During his stay in Turkey, General Jashari, accompanied by General Guler, was hosted in an official



meeting by the Minister of Defense of Turkey, Hulusi Akar, where they discussed a number of issues starting from security developments in Europe, those in the region and challenges in the security and defense sector. A special topic of discussion was Turkey's support for Kosovo for participation in the Partnership for Peace program and the NATO membership process. Among other things, with the Minister of Defense, General Jashari discussed the close cooperation and support from the Republic of Turkey and the Ministry of Defense of Turkey towards the modernization of the systems and equipment of the Kosovo Security Force. Likewise, General Jashari was received with high honors at the General Staff of the Turkish Armed Forces, by Chief General Guler. In the meeting with General Guler, the participation with an excellent performance of the KSF members in the international field exercise in Turkey "EFES'2022" was discussed. General Jashari also visited the Land Force Command and the Special Forces Command. On this occasion, General Jashari, from the commanders of the relevant units, was informed of their developments and capacities. With the commanders of these units, he agreed to increase the number of KSF members participating in training and professional education offered by them.

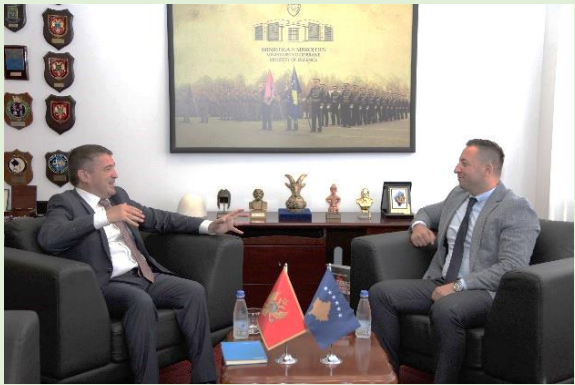
