The support of the Republic of Turkey and its Ministry of Defense is very important in the development process of the KSF.

The next donation in the amount of about 75 thousand dollars, includes the special vehicle for transporting personnel and specialized equipment for interventions in operations against dangerous substances. Similar donations in addition to training support, DTRA will continue in the future for the further development and advancement of chemical, atomic, biological, and radiological defense capacities.



THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE CONTINUES WITH NEXT SUCCESSES



At the Government meeting, held on July 20, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, presented three draft laws to amend/supplement the laws of the Ministry of Defense, the Kosovo Security Force and the Service in the Kosovo Security Force, which after they were approved with complete unanimity.

Minister Mehaj emphasized that the approval of these draft laws ensures the creation of a modern legal basis for the Ministry, the Forces and our own military, advancing and strengthening our determination as a serious aspirant for membership in NATO and

other international security mechanisms. Also the next success is the approval of the final proposal-decision for expropriation in the public interest of immovable properties located within the location of the former Airport of Gjakova, for the needs of the realization of the infrastructure projects of the Ministry of Defense, in the cadastral areas Bec, Trakaniq and Janush of the Municipality of Gjakova. The Government of Kosovo with the approval of the final decision on expropriation creates opportunities for the beginning of the implementation of the projects planned by the Ministry of Defense and through expropriation enables the realization of the rights of the owners of the properties for expropriation.



GENDER PERSPECTIVE IN MILITARY OPERATIONS

As a continuation of the bilateral cooperation with the Italian army, the Ministry of Defense held a seminar on “Gender Perspective in Military Operations”, supported by the Gender Policy Section of the Personnel Division of the General Staff of the Italian Forces. During this seminar, it was discussed about the importance of strengthening the role of women within the army, institutions that have a direct impact on maintaining stability, peace, and security, and through this assistance that the army can provide in peacekeeping missions with special emphasis on assistance to women. Given that women make up over 50% of the population in Kosovo and in the world, the involvement of women in crisis management, their engagement in peacekeeping missions is indispensable.



US INDEPENDENCE DAY WAS CELEBRATED BY RUNNING IN THE HUMANITARIAN MINI MARATHON “RUN FOR AUTISM 2022”
