



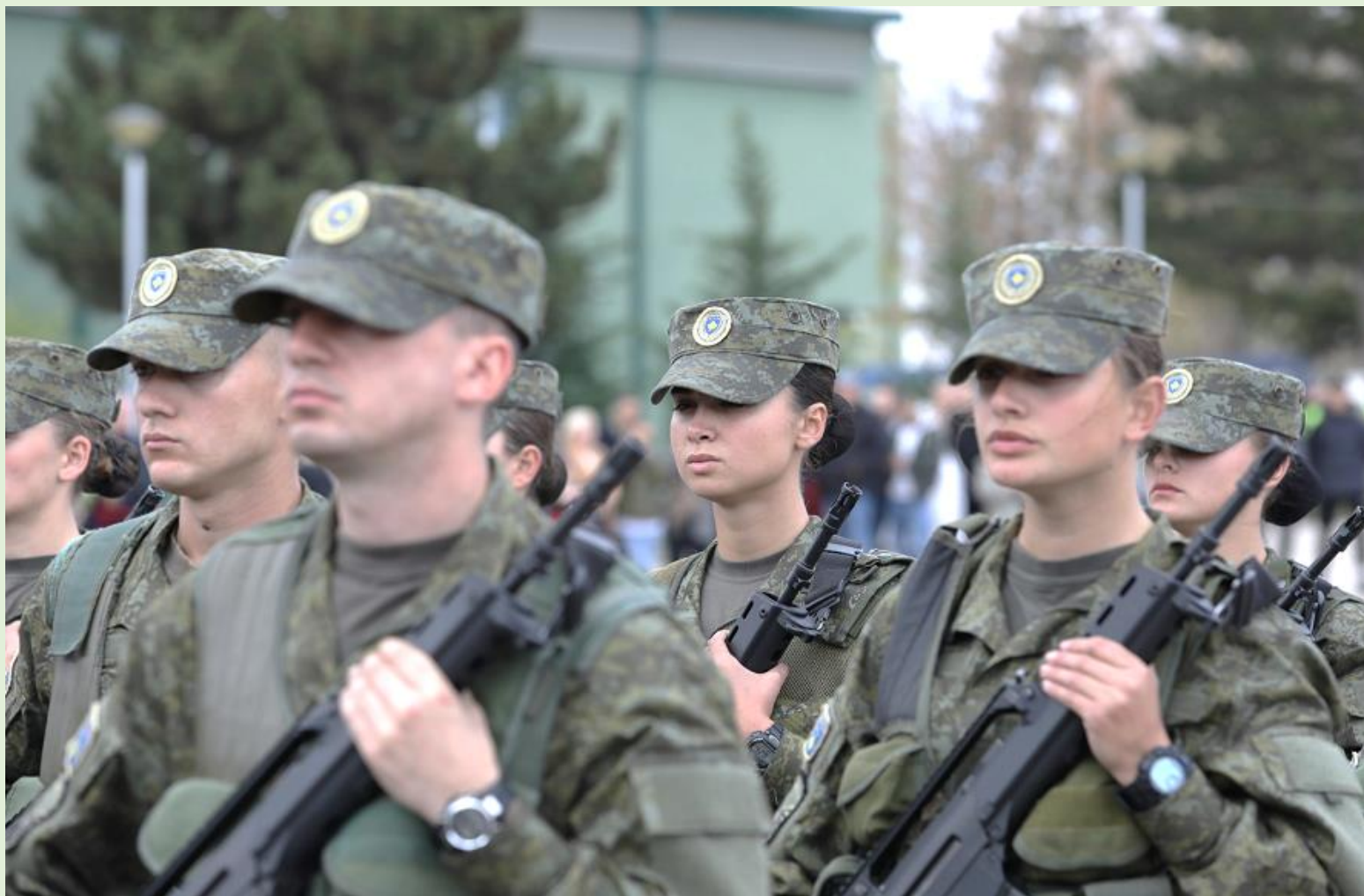

A NEW VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT IS ANNOUNCED FOR RECRUITMENT OF 612 ACTIVE SOLDIERS AND 388 MEMBERS OF THE RESERVE COMPONENT



After the successful completion of the recruitment of the contingent of 840 young soldiers, in the month of December the next vacancy announcement was announced for the recruitment of 612 active soldiers and 367 members of the reserve component and with this the previous recruitment plan was exceeded.

The Ministry of Defense, to all interested parties, has guaranteed a fair and transparent process, in full applicability of the procedures and criteria where the best of the best will be selected.

The Ministry of Defense welcomes applications from all, encouraging girls and women and all young men and women regardless of ethnicity.



MINISTER MEHAJ WAS HOSTED WITH HIGH MILITARY HONORS AT THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF FINLAND

At the invitation of his counterpart, the Minister of Defense of Finland, Antti Kaikkonen, the Minister of Defense Armend Mehaj, together with the delegation comprised of General Gëzim Hazrolli, General Irfete Spahiu, as well as the political advisor, Liridona Gashi, paid an official visit in Finland. After the reception with high military honors, a meeting was held between the two ministers where they discussed the current geopolitical situation, the chain effect that Russian aggression has on the decision of Ukraine and Finland to apply to NATO, as well as the importance of expanding this alliance with the aim guaranteeing stability and peace. Also, the two ministers discussed the areas in which they will cooperate in the future, with special emphasis on the education and training of new military cadres, as well as the realization of joint winter exercises.



As part of the official visit to Finland, Minister Mehaj together with his delegation visited the University of National Defense, where he was received by its rector, General Mika Kalliomaa. On this occasion, they talked about the increase of cooperation in the field of education of new military cadres of the Army of the Republic of Kosovo at this University as well as the education system of the Finnish defense in general. They also agreed that next year to begin with the first groups of soldiers to continue with the other generations.

With this, the expansion of new partnerships and bilateral cooperation is being strongly continued as one of the main strategic objectives of the Ministry of Defense.

Moreover, during this official visit, Minister Mehaj together with the high delegation visited the International Center for the Prevention and Combating of Hybrid War, Hybrid CoE, part of which are 32 member states of the European Union and NATO. With the members of the secretariat of this center and its leader, Rasmus Hindren, Minister Mehaj discussed about the hybrid war that Russia is currently applying in many directions, through Serbia and in the Balkan region.

Subsequently, the two delegations agreed to begin cooperation in the exchange of information and analysis of hybrid threats, finding a strategy for protection and prevention of such activities that violate the democratic values of the states.



THE VISIT OF THE GERMAN CHIEF OF DEFENSE, A CONFIRMATION OF CLOSE COOPERATION BETWEEN THE MINISTRIES AND FORCES OF THE TWO PARTNER COUNTRIES



The Chief of Defense of Germany, General Eberhard Zorn in December was hosted with the highest military honors by the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari. During this visit, the opportunity was used for the German side to officially hand over to the KSF, a donation of specialist protective clothing against explosive devices for the Demining/EOD teams of the KSF.

Also, General Zorn was hosted by the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, who expressed his thanks and gratitude for the support so far in general and the donation

given on the occasion of this visit.

On this occasion, Minister Mehaj emphasized that the friendship with the Federal Republic of Germany flows naturally as a link from the past that continues to deepen with the continuous cooperation between the two countries, evidence of which is the continuous help we receive from this country, as well as today we accepted the donation of demining equipment.



MINISTER MEHAJ HOSTED FOR A THE MEETING THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF THE CROATIAN ARMY, ADMIRAL ROBERT HRANJ



The Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, accompanied by the deputy commander of the KSF, Major General Enver Cikaqi, as well as his delegation, welcomed the Chief of Staff of the Croatian Army, Admiral Robert Hranj, with the accompanying delegation.

In addition to the discussion about the high level of bilateral cooperation, this meeting also discussed the current geopolitical situation after the Russian aggression in Ukraine, the impact on the security environment in the Balkans, as well as the importance of cooperation between the allied states of this region to fight

hybrid attacks.

In this meeting, Minister Mehaj informed Admiral Hranj about the advancements of the KSF, as well as the function that the Agency for Security Intelligence will have, through which the cooperation between the states in the management of important information in terms of security will increase.

They also discussed about the signing of the SOFA agreement, the joint landing of the forces of both countries, as well as the importance of supporting our friendly country Croatia, in the process of joining the Partnership for Peace Program, as a path to membership in the family of large Euro-Atlantic, in NATO.



AT THE CONCLUSION OF 2022, PRESIDENT OSMANI AND GENERAL JASHARI VISIT THE COMMAND OF THE LAND FORCES

At the conclusion of 2022, the President of the Republic of Kosovo, Vjosa Osmani-Sadriu, accompanied by the Commander of the KSF, Lieutenant General Bashkim Jashari, visited the barracks of the KSF, “NATO Soldiers” in Istog and addressed you soldiers of Kosovo with the annual speech. President Osmani thanked all the members of the KSF for their selfless service to the country and also thanked the strategic partners for the continuous support they have given in building and maintaining the capacities of the KSF.



In her speech, President Osmani emphasized the readiness of the KSF to contribute to peace and security in the region and anywhere in the world. Within the framework of participation in the Forum for Cooperation of Central Europe in the field of defense, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj met his counterpart, also the host of the forum, the Minister of Defense of the Republic of Austria, Klaudia Tanner.

On this occasion, Minister Tanner expressed her evaluations regarding the advancements of the Army of the Republic of Kosovo, the pro-European stance regarding the Russian aggression against Ukraine, as well as the readiness to cooperate in the field of defense, through joint training between the forces of both states.

During the proceedings of the CEDS+ Forum, Minister Mehaj held a fraternal meeting with his counterpart, the Minister of Defense of the Republic of Albania, Niko Peleshi. On this occasion, the two ministers shared their satisfaction with the joint successes during this year, pledging to increase cooperation in the field of education and joint military exercises in the coming year, with a focus on strengthening the readiness for operational interaction according to the concept "Smart Defense".

During the work of this Forum, Minister Mehaj met the Minister of Defense of the Republic of Croatia, Mario Banozic.



On this occasion, Minister Mehaj reiterated that the friendship with the Croatian state dates back to early times.

"As two countries with a similar past, we understand very well the seriousness of the current geopolitical situation and the importance of the cooperation of the European states in the field of defense, with special emphasis on the Western Balkans, where the trends of Russian influence are clearly visible" he said.

MINISTER MEHAJ HOSTED FOR A MEETING THE AMBASSADOR OF THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA IN KOSOVO, DANIJELA BARISIC

Following the meetings with the diplomatic and military representatives of the partner countries, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj, hosted the ambassador of the Republic of Croatia in Kosovo, Danijela Barisic.

Also, there were discussions about the advancements of the army in raising professional and operational capacities, the willingness we have continuously expressed to provide support in international operations, for the transportation of Afghans, as well as the training of Ukrainian soldiers in the field of demining, search and rescue and elimination of dangerous substances.

On this occasion, Minister Mehaj emphasized once again that our goal is membership in NATO and the EU, in which journey we seek the support of each friendly country, including the Federal Republic of Germany.

The objective of the training program for a period of 8 weeks was the career advancement of non-commissioned officers to the position

of deputy platoon commander, providing theoretical-practical knowledge for platoon management, the levels calculated with them, as well as in terms of training as managers and leaders. near the KSF regimental commands.

KSF IS TRAINED AT THE MILITARY RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC

In the framework of the bilateral cooperation with the United States of America and the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA), the members of the FSK (Hazardous Materials Company) have conducted training at the Military Research Institute (Military Research Institute) in Vyskov, Republic of the Czech Republic.

The training “Live Agent Training” aims to train members for operations against chemical warfare agents, and the purpose of the training is to increase the confidence of members for protective clothing, equipment, detection and decontamination of various chemical warfare agents such as Sarin, Mustard, Lewisite and Vx.

As a sign of gratitude for the Institute of Military Research, the Commander of the KSF, Lt. General Bashkim Jashari, awarded a decoration to the director of the Institute, Mr. Jindrich Dvorak.
