KSF REMOVES 143 EXPLOSIVE ORDNANCES

The EOD teams of the Kosovo Security Force assisted by the Kosovo Police and the Swiss KFOR EOD team removed 143 explosive ordnances from the vicinity of the Peja 2 electrical substation, in the Dardania neighborhood in Peja.

During the 2-day operation, these dangerous remains dating back to the time of the First World War, which endangered the safety of the residents, were removed. The remains were encountered during the works for the laying of electricity in the neighborhood.

The ordnances have been safely towed and will be destroyed in a controlled manner in the coming days in a secure area.

A safe and harmless environment from poisonous and radioactive materials is the mission of the Hazardous Materials Company (HMC) of the National Guard of the Kosovo Security Force. Together with our strategic partners, KFOR, NALT, they are in areas identified as a source of

danger, their hard work has made it possible to identify and eliminate many substances that are a danger to the lives of citizens.

The last inspection was carried out in the "Metaliku" factory of the municipality of Gjakova, where the condition of the industrial waste repackaged at the beginning of the year by the HMC of the KSF was verified.
