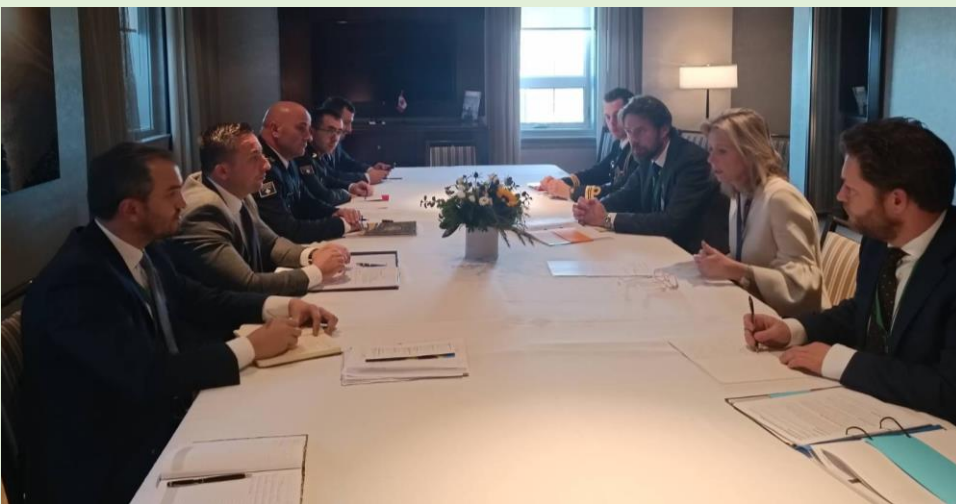
REPUBLIC OF KOSOVO AND POLAND, ALLIES OF PEACE

MARTIAL ARTS, PART OF KSF TRAINING

Starting from November, the Ministry of Defense has begun implementing the objective of Minister Mehaj defined at the beginning of his mandate to raise the professional skills of our soldiers through the inclusion of martial arts in the Kosovo Security Force.

In order to realize our goal that the KSF be trained by elite judo athletes and the Kosovo Security Force to participate in the international multi-disciplinary competitions of the CISM organization for the armed forces, the Minister of Defense, Armend Mehaj hosted for a meeting the Minister of Culture, Youth and Sport, Hajrulla Çekun, Deputy Minister Daulina Osmani, the President of the Kosovo Judo Federation, Agron Kuka, the Selector of the Kosovo Judo Representation, Driton Kuka, and our JUDO champions.

On this occasion, Minister Mehaj informed the attendees of the concept of martial arts in the KSF and the intentions of the Ministry of Defense for the inclusion of judokas in security institutions as trainers of new military personnel.

Also, Minister Mehaj emphasized that this plan goes beyond the state project for young people "Kosovo-Judo State".

He estimated that the incorporation of judo in security institutions, for the purpose of the institutional integration of martial arts, with a focus on the sport of judo, in the permanent educational and training program of KSF members, will put our judokas at the service of KSF already proven in world competitions, and on the other hand, through this project, the professionalism and talent of our judokas will be evaluated by engaging them in our institutions.

Italy and the Kosovo Security Force.

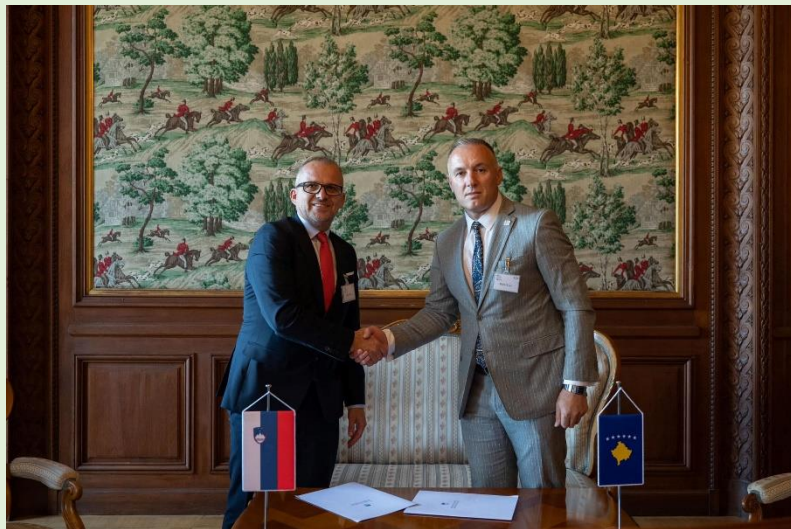
The two sides agreed that the cooperation in the future will be expanded and intensified even further.
